Rear Brake Hose

Problem

After applying the parking brake the rear brake caliper becomes seized in operation, which could take 5-10 minutes to move freely again.

This problem can affect either side separately or both sides together.

Cause

The rear caliper brake hose swells internally, causing a partial blockage.

This restricts the flow of brake fluid to the brake caliper, subsequently making the brake operation intermittent.

Solution

Upon inspection, the seized brake caliper will immediately become free in operation when the bleed nipple is released.

As a result, the rear brake caliper, brake pads and handbrake mechanism should now be moving freely.

Replace with a new brake hose (or hoses) and bleed the brake system using a suitable DOT 4 brake fluid. This should be followed by an operational test of the brake system to check that it is now functioning correctly.
